

The Truth about Cancer: Killer Disease or a Cry for Help

If this does not sound right, then consider the alternative: Cancer does not appear, causing a person to become sick; instead, cancer is merely a sign of the unstable condition the body is already in, due to lack of proper care. Cancer, in fact, and everything that goes with it, is part of the body's ingenious attempt to survive. Once the cause of the cancer is identified and corrective measures are taken to restore balance to the body, many forms of cancer are overcome as easily and quickly as getting over a case of the flu.

It is a proven medical fact that each of us have cancer cells in our body at all times. These cells are not detected through medical testing unless they have multiplied into the billions. Once a person has been medically treated for cancer and the doctor announces they are “cancer free,” all that really means is that enough cancer cells have been successfully destroyed to fall below the traceable levels.

A real cure for cancer has little to do with simply destroying enough cancer cells to temporarily achieve the desired reading when conducting a cell test. Treatments such as radiation and chemotherapy effectively poison and burn away many of these cells, but this type of aggressive treatment also destroys healthy cells in the liver, bone marrow, kidneys, lungs, and heart. The treatments often cause irreparable damage to entire organs and bodily functions. This damage leads to hundreds of thousands of deaths each year from infections, liver and kidney failure, heart attacks, and other illnesses due to the infections and damage caused by the treatment.

Dr. Ulrich Abel of the University of Heidelberg, who has been personally involved in years of research and assessment of chemotherapy concluded, “that positive results (excepting, of course pharmaceutical company profits) are at best wishful thinking or correlated statistics.” A true cure for cancer would not occur at the expense of destroying other vital body parts.

To deal with the root causes of cancer, you must choose to find sound answers to the reason for

it's arrival. The decision to restore balance to all aspects of your life; emotional, mental, physical, and spiritual is the first step to removing all causes of cancer from your life.

So, if the presence of cancer is not an invasion of malicious enemy cells, with the agenda to kill us; what is it?

Cancer cells, as stated above, are really an attempt at survival. When cancer cells begin to multiply and spread throughout the body, it is not their goal to interrupt vital bodily functions, contaminate healthy cells and destroy the host body that keeps them alive. Self-destruction is not the agenda of any cell unless it is old and ready to be replaced. Like all other cells, cancerous cells operate on the premise that if their host dies, they will cease to exist as well.

The key point to remember here, is that the cells developed the ability to live in an oxygen deprived state. The obvious question here would be; who or what caused the lack of oxygen? The answer, as you may have guessed, is of our own doing.
